You'll also visit each of the arts schools, plus general areas such as the student commons and the new library. All on 75 rolling acres of tree-lined green space with a pedestrian-friendly central plaza. Guided campus tours are offered almost every weekday (typically 90 minutes in duration). ACCOMMODATIONS & AIRPORTS

UNCSA is located just two miles from downtown Winston-Salem, so you'll find plenty of convenient options when choosing a place to stay.

The area is easily accessible by air, with Piedmont Triad International Airport in Greensboro (GSO) only 22 miles away. International airports in Charlotte and Raleigh-Durham are less than a two-hour drive away.
