Parents will be sent a copy of their student's score report with a "Parent Tutorial" from CollegeBoard on using PSAT scores for future college and SAT prep. This information will be mailed mid January.

The UNCSA High School Academic Program is again offering SAT Prep courses in *Critical Reading* and *Math*. This is great time for 11th grade students to prepare for SAT administration during the upcoming months.

The SAT Prep courses are recommended for juniors and seniors. The cost is \$125 per course. Payment can be made by check (made payable to UNCSA) or by cash in the HS Academic Program Office. Registration will begin January 9th, 2012.
