



# A MEAL PLAN OFFERS YOU REAL VALUE!

**Real convenience, flexibility and variety. And helps you save your cash for better things!**

If you are a residential high school student you are automatically signed up for the full meal plan - High School 19-Meal Plan.

If you are a college freshmen or sophomore living in the residence halls, you are automatically signed up for the full meal plan - College 300 Meal Plan.

College freshman and sophomores living in Bailey Street Apartments as well as college juniors and seniors are automatically signed up for the College 175 Meal Plan. These students will have the option to sign up for the College 300 Meal Plan.

Students, faculty and staff eligible for the 20, 30 or 50 Block Plan may sign up for one of these plans in the Dining Office located in the Dining Hall.

### Late-Night Pickle Exchange

Nightly from 7:30 p.m. - close

Late-Night meals can be obtained at the Pickle Jar Monday through Friday (7:30 pm - midnight), in exchange for dinner in the dining hall\*. Designated items and meals will be available for the exchange. Ask about these meal equivalencies at the Pickle Jar.

\* The exchange is good for dinner only, and is valid only if no meal was used during dinner hours in the Dining Hall. Exception - college students on the College 300 or 175 Meal Plans will be able to swipe their One Card for the meal exchange even if they've eaten dinner in the dining hall.

### Take-out Boxes

Students, faculty or staff members who do not have time to sit down in the dining hall to eat a meal may purchase one (1) eco-clam take-out box for \$5 from the cashier as they enter. These are reusable containers that are environmentally friendly and will save on the cost of the 200+ containers used daily previously. **Individuals who receive a take-out box may not consume any food while in the dining hall.**

# A PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE, YOUR SCHEDULE.

When you purchase a meal plan, you get:

**1. Credit for a certain amount** of all-you-care-to-eat meals at the Dining Hall in Hanes Student Commons.

**2. Bonus Bucks** you can spend at the Pickle Jar.

Note: High school commuter students may sign up for the 10-meal plan or one of the block plans. College juniors and seniors living in Bailey Street Apartments and students residing in the Center Stage Apartments, regardless of classification, are not required to purchase a meal plan. Those college residents as well as college commuter students are encouraged to purchase one of the block plans.

## High School 19-Meal Plan

- Receive 19 all-you-care-to-eat meals each Sunday
- \$100 Bonus Bucks/ semester
- \$2,100/semester

- All residential high school students are required to be on this plan.



## High School 10-Meal Plan

- Receive 10 all-you-care-to-eat meals each Sunday
- \$100 Bonus Bucks/ semester
- \$1,464/semester

- \*High school commuters classified as NC residents are automatically assigned to this plan.



## College 300 Meal Plan\*

- Receive 300 all-you-care-to-eat meals each semester
- \$150 Bonus Bucks/ semester
- \$2,011/semester

- All college freshmen and sophomores living in the residence halls must participate in this plan.



## College 175 Meal Plan\*

- Receive 175 all-you-care-to-eat meals each semester
- \$150 Bonus Bucks/ semester
- \$1,398/semester

- College freshmen and sophomores in Bailey Street Apartments and College juniors and seniors living in the residence halls must select this plan or the College 300 Meal Plan.

- \* Once you use your allotment of meals for the semester, you will have to use cash, Pickle Dollars, Bonus Bucks or purchase a block plan to eat more meals in the dining hall.

- Students on a meal plan can eat only once during each meal period.



## Block Plans

- 20 meals = \$110.00 or \$5.50/ meal
- 30 meals = \$160.00 or \$5.33/ meal
- 50 meals = \$250.00 or \$5.00/ meal

- Student block plans expire at the end of each academic year. Faculty/staff block plans do not expire. Block meals can be purchased from the Dining Office in the Dining Hall.
