CONDITIONS:

- Patrons are allowed one guest; any other memberships must be an immediate family member (dependants).
- Payroll deduction memberships are for one year period. If you join any time after the 5th of the month, payroll deduction will begin the following pay period. *(For example, if joining date is January 10th, payroll deduction will begin with your February check. The membership period would run from January 10th oh the year through January 9th of the next year.)*
- When terminating payroll deduction, you must do so by the 5th of the month for it to be effective that month. Anything processed after that date means a deduction will be taken for that month.
- If you terminate payroll deduction before one year membership period is up, you lose the privilege of payroll deduction for one year.
- Illness, injury, job transfer or terminations are the only conditions justifying termination of payroll deduction.

The cost of 1 one year membership is \$140.00. Although this rate is subject to change, members will be locked in at the rate in effect at the beginning of membership for one year.

I agree to have \$11.66, \$23.32 or \$ _____ per month deducted from my paycheck for the purpose of maintaining an NCSA Fitness Center membership. I understand that in case of a rate increase, this monthly deduction will increase and I will be required to sign a new payroll deduction authorization form.
