OPENING DAY SCHEDULE ■ SUNDAY, JUNE 19, 2011

- 8:00 am – 9:00 am** CHECK-IN for Last Names, A-I
9:15 am – 10:15 am CHECK-IN for Last Names, J-R
10:30 am - 11:30 am CHECK-IN for Last Names, S-Z
11:45 am - 1:00 pm Open CHECK-IN for all remaining students, if cannot arrive by above scheduled time
- 1st stop: BB&T Lobby - Film Village – pick up:
- Clearance / enrollment form – this is for **all students** (*living on campus & commuters*) (**carry this form with you to the 2nd stop: Eisenberg Social Hall**)
 - This form will tell you if you have “holds.” Holds must be cleared before you proceed. “Hold” indicates there is a potential issue with your billing or health records. Staff will be on hand to assist you in clearing holds. **Billing and health holds must be cleared prior to parents leaving campus.** You will not be able to begin classes until all holds are cleared. (Student Accounts located at Welcome Center, 2nd floor; Health Services located at Hanes Student Commons, top floor)
 - Housing Packet and Room key (if you have no “holds”), if living on campus.
 - Instructions for unloading vehicles
 - Get One Card (*if photo was previously submitted*)
- 2nd stop: Eisenberg Social Hall - Hanes Student Commons (lower level)
- One Card – **only** if you didn’t receive it at BB&T Lobby when you initially checked in (1st stop). Have picture taken and One Card made. Your One Card is your photo ID, access, meal plan and prepaid flexible spending account card. *Necessary for lunch, so be sure to pick up before lunch.*
 - Deposit cash or check into your “Pickle Dollars” account if desired (check made payable to “UNCSA One Card”). We recommend adding a minimum amount of \$10 to cover the expense of replacing your One Card, if it is lost.
 - Commuter Students can purchase a meal plan for the Dining Hall. (*Cash or Check only*)
 - Parking decal - \$20.00 (required if you are a commuter student or college students driving a car to campus. If you have a current year decal, it remains valid through the summer program).
 - Sign up for Community Music School lessons if desired.
- 3rd stop: Mail Center - Hanes Student Commons (lower level next to the Campus Store)
Students here for only 1 or 2 weeks do not receive a mailbox assignment.
- Get your mailbox assignment and combination
 - Make sure the combination works
- 4th stop: Summer Trips, Activities & Events –Eisenberg Lobby, Commons (lower level)
- Sign up and pay for activities and trips (space is limited for some trips).
 - Purchase a souvenir t-shirt.

LATE ARRIVALS ON OPENING DAY: If you arrive after 1:00 pm on Sunday, please park in the Welcome Center lot, and report to the Quad Office (*located between residence halls C & D; phone 336-770-3373*) to get your room key. You will be given a temporary One Card for identification, meals and building access. Then drive your vehicle to your Residence Hall, unload quickly and move your vehicle to the R lot (*below the Fitness Center*). Report to the Admissions Office (Welcome Center, 1st floor) at 8:00 am on Monday, June 20 to register and be cleared for a regular One Card. (If your temporary One Card has your picture on it, that is your regular One Card and you don't need to stop by the One Card Office unless you want to put money onto your card).

MEALS FOR OPENING DAY: Dining Hall - Hanes Student Commons 11:00 am – 2:00 pm for lunch: This is the first meal of the meal plan. 4:30 pm – 7:00 pm for dinner. The Pickle Jar, Hanes Student Commons: 8:00 am – 9:30 pm. Cash, credit, and One Card prepaid flexible spending accounts (Pickle Dollars) are accepted.

MEALS FOR COMMUTER STUDENTS: Commuter students can purchase a meal plan called Block Meals. Visit Dining Services table at Eisenberg Social Hall, Hanes Student Commons on Opening Day Sunday between 8:00 am – 1:00 pm, or Monday through Friday between 9:00 am – 5:00 pm at Dining Services Office inside Dining Hall.

ATM: Located inside the Mail Center, Hanes Student Commons. It is operated by the North Carolina State Employees Credit Union, which does not charge a fee for use of the machine. Your banking institution, however, may levy a fee.

COMPUTER ACCESS: A computer lab is located in Hanes Student Commons, accessed by swiping your One Card. Residential students can connect for free in your rooms, providing you have a 10/100 Ethernet cable and are current on all Windows updates. If you do not have a virus protection program, one can be provided. Call the Information Technologies help desk (336) 770-3300 Monday through Friday from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm for more information.

ONE CARD: Your One Card is a valuable tool. With security readers on most doors, we offer a level of convenience and security that could not be provided with a conventional keyed system. Your One Card carries the details of your meal plan and has a prepaid flexible spending account feature that makes purchases on campus convenient, fast and easy. The money deposited into the flexible spending account is called ***Pickle Dollars***. (Cash cannot be drawn on the account.).

Only put on your card the money you believe you will need. Money left on your card at the end of Summer Programs cannot be refunded. You or your parents can arrange to have additional funds deposited into your ***Pickle Dollars*** account throughout the summer. Please keep your One Card with you at all times. Funds on the One Card can be used on campus like cash – by you or by anyone who has possession of your card. Report a lost card immediately to the One Card Office or UNCSA Police. The One Card Office is located on the lower level of Hanes Student Commons, adjacent to the Computer Lab. Office Hours are from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

ABOUT THE FOURTH OF JULY: Classes will not be in session on Monday, July 4 for dance, drama (acting), music, and visual arts. Classes will be held on Monday, July 4 for stage combat and filmmaking. Dining Hall operates a regular schedule.

SUMMER PROGRAMS / LAST DAY: The **4-week** programs officially end at 6:00 pm on Friday, July 15 and residence halls close at noon on Saturday, July 16. The **3-week** programs end at 6:00 pm on Friday, July 8 and residence halls close at noon on Saturday, July 9. All residential students must be moved out at those times. SAFETY ON CAMPUS

UNCSA Police Officers patrol campus buildings and grounds 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Police Department is the primary means for emergency first response for a crime, suspicious circumstance, medical crisis, intrusion/fire alarm, or other critical incident situation.

Officers routinely respond to a range of calls for service from the campus community. Some of the services that the UNCSA Police Department provides are: security escorts, bicycle registration, property engraving program, crime prevention and safety programming, parking enforcement and lost and found.

The UNCSA Police Department has the capability to issue campus emergency alerts via CUKES (email & text message) and the outdoor emergency notification system.

The UNCSA Police Department is committed to facilitating a strong partnership with the campus community for the purposes of solving problems, preventing crime, fostering personal safety, and protecting UNCSA and individual property. Safety and security are shared responsibilities and it is only through this mutual partnership and understanding that we can all be successful.

UNCSA is committed to establishing and maintaining a safe learning environment, free from assaultive crimes. Fighting, sexual assault, threatening and harassing behavior are considered very serious crimes and will not be tolerated at UNCSA.

North Carolina General Statue § 14-269.2 prohibits the possession of firearms, knives and fireworks on UNCSA property. North Carolina General Statue § 18B-302 prohibits any person under twenty-one (21) to purchase or possess any alcoholic beverage. North Carolina General Statutes (§90-89 through §90-95) prohibit the possession, sale, use, delivery, or manufacture of drugs designated collectively as "controlled substances."

UNCSA does not allow the possession or use of tobacco products by any high school student on school grounds or on school trips. In addition, skateboards, roller blades or roller skates are not allowed on school grounds.

The UNCSA Police Department prepares reports and investigates all crimes that occur on any property owned or controlled by UNCSA. Any crime or suspicious situation should be reported immediately to the UNCSA Police Department.

To report a crime, suspicious situation or emergency on UNCSA property:

- * Dial 336-770-3362 from cell or off-campus phones, or
- * Use any Emergency Call Box located throughout campus.
