SYNOPSIS:

It's dawn at the Meadow and the villagers start arriving for a day of hard work. Among them, Anna, a young villager who enjoys the company of her friends, the grass cutters and the seeders.

As the sun starts to set, everyone heads home to their families... everyone but Anna. Curious about the world, she ventures deep into the forest where she lays to rest her eyes after a long day of work.

Eartha, a powerful sorceress who spends her days making potions alongside her faithful minions, appears next to her. Anna wakes up startled by their presence. Eartha offers her a potion that will allow her to hear the unheard. As Eartha commences to explain the full effects of the potion, she is mocked by Anna who ceases listening and pays her no attention. Eartha, mad and offended, disappears.

Anna, unbothered by the strange event, starts making her way back to the meadow across the garden, when she starts hearing voices calling her name. As she looks down, she can't believe that it is the garden that its speaking to her. Soon, the English Peas, the Eggplants and the Spanish Olives appear to introduce themselves and dance for Anna.

After such an exciting night, Anna can't wait to return to the meadow to tell all her friends about her adventures.

When she returns, she realizes that she can't be heard or hear any of her friends. Sad with desperation at being tricked by Eartha, Anna decides to go back, deep into the forest, to find Eartha and ask for her forgiveness in the hope that she will reverse the effects of the potion.

Eartha, by nature a kind soul, forgives Anna and explains to her that you just can't listen with your ears, but with your mind and heart to truly understand and appreciate the full beauty of the world around you.
