UNCSA Faculty Qualification Requirements

- Faculty teaching graduate level courses must possess:
 - ▶ Earned doctorate/terminal degree in the teaching discipline or a related discipline or
 - Equivalent professional/experiential qualifications or
 - ▶ Equivalent combination of education and professional experience
- Faculty teaching undergraduate level courses must possess:
 - ▶ Earned doctorate or master's degree in the teaching discipline or
 - Earned master's degree with a minimum of 18 graduate semester hours in the teaching discipline or
 - ► Equivalent professional/experiential qualifications or
 - Equivalent combination of education and professional experience
- Faculty teaching high school level arts courses must possess:
 - ▶ Earned doctorate, master's, or bachelor's degree in the teaching discipline or
 - ▶ Earned bachelor's degree with a minimum of 24 semester hours in the teaching discipline or
 - ► Equivalent professional/experiential qualifications or
 - Equivalent combination of education and professional experience

Roles and Responsibilities

Search Committee

Completes the Credential Assessment for Faculty Hiring Recommendation and forwards it to the Dean/Designee and the Admin.

Dean

- Communicates requirement for official transcripts and substantiating documentation to Candidate upon offer of employment.
- Provides guidance to the Candidate regarding gathering supporting documentation or refers Candidate to Dean Designee, as applicable.
- ▶ The dean will name a designee to complete the Credential Assessment for Faculty Hiring Recommendation when hiring visiting faculty. The designee may be the faculty member recommending the new hire, the department/discipline chair, or another faculty member who is qualified to assess the individual's credentials.
