- UNCSA Symphony Orchestra conductor (and school alum) Robert Franz passed away after battling cancer
- Main focuses early in the semester have been:
  - Personnel and salary caps created by UNC System in anticipation of likely budget cuts to come when the state legislature passes a budget
  - Almost \$700,000 over the salary cap in August
  - Currently almost \$5,000 under the salary cap
  - We are currently in compliance with the BoG policies
  - New policy for every BoT to have a sub-committee that monitors the compliance of the institution
  - Expand the work of the Chancellor's A.I. Task Force under Bruhn
  - Looking at convening an Arts and A.I. Summit funded by the Kenan Institute of the Arts
