These budgets have been calculated as an estimate of what it will cost a student to live and attend school for the 2022-2023 academic year. The "TOTAL" is more than a student will owe the school ("Direct Costs") which depends on attendance and living arrangements. (For planning purposes, keep in mind that costs usually increase each year.)

Tuition for in-state high school students is provided free of charge. The majority of remaining educational costs (text books, health and wellness services, room and board, social and cultural activities, etc.) is covered by the North Carolina High School Artists Grant. Direct Costs to the family for the 2022-2023 Academic Year is estimated to be \$1700 for commuter students and \$3100 for residential students, subject to change due to NC legislative action.
