- What is ASG?
 - UNC School System Association of Student Government.
 - Friday and Saturday Conference.
 - Friday is mostly campus life, how to develop?

- Saturday is meetings with committees, biggest one for UNCSA is the Budgeting and Finance Committee. We can apply for grants.
- How does it impact UNCSA and SGA?
 - With grants each school has to have one vote and that will come from our UNCSA liaison.
 - A big way to get grants is prove that it will impact a large campus community.
 - This money has to go into a club bank account and we could funnel it through SGA account because most clubs don't have one.
 - But we absolutely have to have a liaison present.
- ASG 2018-19 Schedule
 - TBA, Thatcher has 2 schedules.
 - There is a meeting the 21st and 22nd of September.
- Liaison Selection
 - You have to be trained in the Budget and Finance Committee, we can train up to two or three people. One of these people have to go.
 - Liaison is a payed position.

SGA Associates - [Greer/Steve: 12-15 minutes]

- Role: Initially, it was people of interest in SGA. They came to all meetings, sat in, and listened. Gave occasional input. Essentially on-call volunteers. It was suspended for a while due to Associates being more visible and involved than Executives.
- Greer and Steve are currently reassessing the role. Thinking towards 10 volunteers, with one SGA meeting a month to give them the floor and express concerns, issues, campus life, etc.
- Possible Benefits: Someone learning in order to take over, Beneficial for freshman to get involved, great for student engagement. There is also a desire from freshman to be involved as well. They bring a view of campus that we are not aware of, eyes and ears. It lets Student

Engagement get to know the first years and the students who would like to be Executives.

- Possible Pitfalls: Numbers on the day of? How will the dynamic be? Will they feel heard? Will we be a looming presence? Execs begin to falter and allow associates to volunteer and do everything (this happened in the past).
- Suggestions: Having an Associate liaison and Executive liaison and have separate meetings. From experience, Ryan thinks combining is the most beneficial setup for this.
- Steve is suggesting we do a one semester trial this year. Bring the Associates in and let the team try it out. At the end of every meeting give them the last ten minutes to voice. Maybe every other week? If we don't get to something they can send it to an Executive contact and that contact will put it on the agenda. Roxy is interested in this contact position.
- A hierarchy will be inevitable. A volunteer position gets weeded out very quickly. We will easily see if it works or not.
- We will table it now, 8-10 Associates maybe, and Roxy will facilitate spreading the word.

Other:

- Greer's update on Safety Alert sent out 09/04/18. Campus police would not give Greer any information on the event happening around their house.
- Steve would like to suggest establishing a consistent meeting between 2 SGA Execs and Campus Police. Potentially Edmond and Maura.
- The biggest issue right now: when is too early to send an alert and when is too late?
- Establishing an ongoing conversation will help.
